

Bigland East Cumbrian Galoppen

Travel

The event is signed off the Brow Edge road (SD360833) near Bigland Hall at the top of the hill. DO NOT turn into Bigland Hall entrances. Proceed past the Hall and the entrance to Mungeon Farm and the entrance to the car park field is on the west side of the road.

Parking

IS EXTREMELY LIMITED DUE TO PROLONGED WET WEATHER – PLEASE SHARE IF POSSIBLE.

Please park as directed there will be a £2 per car charge imposed by the Landowner .

Registration

Registration will be between 10am and 12noon and sited on an area of hard standing near the entrance to Car Parking field. Toilets will be in the parking field.

Fees

Senior £6 Junior £3. Surcharge of £2 if non-BOF member. SI Card hire at £1.

Start Times

Start times will be between 10.30am and 12.30pm.

Start and Finish

The route to the Start is right out of the Parking Field entrance and head south along the side of the road for 400metres until turning off on a footpath.

From the parking field it will be a 5 minute walk to the start.

The Finish is North East of Mungeon Farm.

Follow tapes back to the farmyard where you will find download.

From there it is a couple of minutes walk back to the parking field.

There is no clothing dump. No water will be provided.

Cagoules MAY BE compulsory in the event of extreme wet weather.

Courses

White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue, Brown
Loose Control Descriptions will be issued at Registration.

Stock

All Gates MUST be kept closed to avoid stock moving between enclosures.

Courses Orange to Brown will pass through a large enclosure that contains 4 Tamworth pigs.

They are knee high and inquisitive – and will have been fed early!

They have made many new paths which are too small to map.

The main footpaths through this enclosure have been updated on the map.

Another enclosure contains belted Galloway calves. Due to the wet weather the pasture is continually being churned up and new trods created. Only significant small paths are on the map.
