2018 Club Championships and meal, Sunday 14th January

Venue: **Esthwaite Intake** near Hawkshead. Parking on forest roads: access point SD342964.

Meal and annual prize/award distribution at **Greenodd village hall** SD313826. Hall open at 12.15, food served as soon as everyone has arrived - probably before 2pm.

The Championship event is handicapped – the aim being that everyone finishes at 12:00. (Handicapping, based on age-class and recent form, by an expert LOC panel)
Courses – yellow (non competitive), orange, green and blue.
Club champion is the first back.

The meal will be pie and peas (vegetarian option available) with a choice of dessert afterwards. Tea/coffee/squash included; if you want anything else to drink, you are welcome to bring your own and a glass.
