LOC Winter Night Events - Safety

(this can also apply to any other day event... Especially in winter!)

Quick reminder - for **Urban racing**, wear something reflective/bright, and take great care when crossing roads. A spare torch might be useful too...

For **terrain events**, take a bum-bag with a cagoule, whistle, spare battery/torch, and possibly a phone. It's better to have it and not need it, than be without and find you need it...
