Pram/Wheelchair friendly? All-terrain only

COURSES AVAILABLE

This line course/trail follows the footpaths on the open fell.

The long course takes you to the summit of Cunswick Scar for amazing views.

There is also the option to explore a shortened version of this course.

Navigation is relatively easy.

Long	4.2 km	25 controls
Short	2.4 km	15 controls

Parking: National Trust Pay and Display (free to NT members)

Public transport: Accessible by the no.6 bus.

Toilets: In the main car park and near to the cafe.

Pram/Wheelchair friendly? Yes. The orange course may require sturdier wheels.

Well-behaved dogs? Yes



COURSES AVAILABLE

There are three line courses of varied length and difficulty with checkpoints hidden across the park. The orange course extends to the meadow area.

White 0.7 km 14 controls (short and very easy)

Yellow 1.3 km 15 controls (medium and easy)

Orange 2.5 km 16 controls (longer and medium difficulty)

SAFETY NOTES

You take part in this activity at your own risk and children must be supervised by a responsible adult.

This can be a busy park. Please take care to avoid collision with other park users. Please be aware that there is an open lakeshore and river to the west of the park. There are slopes, small crags and undergrowth along the way. Courses avoid the main car parking areas but please take extra care if the overflow parking area is in use.

The start is located on the lakeshore, just south of the cafe area and jetties

Grasmere Village Trail



AREA

What 3 Words: districts.dean.quieter

Parking: Stock Lane Car Park (Pay and Display) or nearby A591 layby (free)

Public transport: Bus stop at Grasmere School

Toilets: Public toilets in car park

Pram/Wheelchair friendly? Yes, apart from a short section in the woods which can be bypassed.

Well behaved dogs? Yes (on a lead)



COURSES AVAILABLE

The line course/trail takes you through the pretty village of Grasmere and its outskirts with some lovely views of the fells along the way. It also visits a woodland and the playground.

This course uses a Street Map rather than a standard orienteering map.

Approx 2km 21 controls

SAFETY NOTES

You take part in this activity at your own risk and children must be supervised by a responsible adult.

This can be a busy village - please take care to avoid collision. Please be aware that there are short roadside sections and road crossings so please look out for traffic. There are slopes, small crags and undergrowth along the way. The trail also follows the open riverside path for a short time.

The start is located on a bridge on the footpath behind Grasmere School

Parking: A591 laybys or Windermere Centre

Public Transport: very close to Windermere

Train station which is also the nearest bus stop.

Toilets: available in Booths.

Pram/Wheelchair friendly? The first half of the course up to the summit is accessible.

Well behaved dogs? Yes



COURSES AVAILABLE

The line course/trail takes you on footpaths to the summit of Orrest Head for amazing views across Windermere to the surrounding fells.

Watch out for the Gruffalo in the woods!
Navigation is relatively easy.

Parking: Miller Bridge Car Park or Under Loughrigg Road

Public transport: short walk from Ambleside Library Bus Station

Toilets: Public toilets in the park

Pram/Wheelchair friendly? Yes (apart from two controls in the woodland section to the North)

Well-behaved dogs? Yes (except in the playground)



COURSES AVAILABLE

This is a score course.

The aim is to visit as many controls as you can in 45 minutes. Each control is worth 10 points, but don't be late to the finish!

The course is suitable for all abilities as you plan your own route and visit the controls that you feel confident that you can find.

This can be a busy park. Please take care to avoid collision with other park users. Please be aware that a section of the park is open to the river and there are numerous crags. 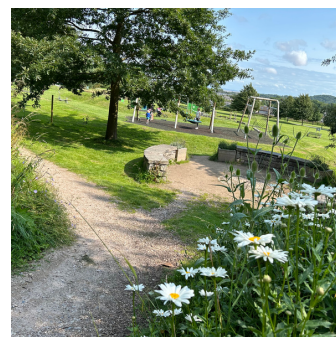
Parking: available in Ford Park

Navigation is relatively easy and the course visits lots of different features along the way.

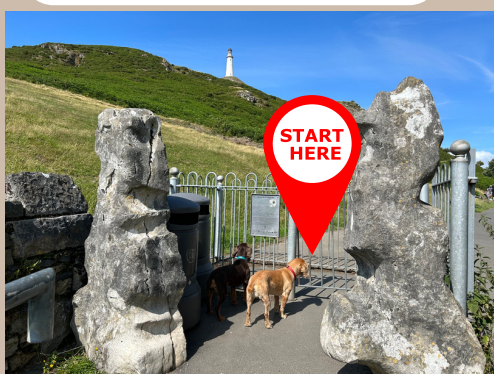
2.5km 25 controls
