History

The fund was originally started as the World Schools Fund in 1997, when Ulverston Victoria HS Orienteering Club were asked to send a team to represent British Schools at the World Schools Orienteering Championships to be held in Italy. The club set about fundraising and all monies were kept in a separate account specifically for funding UVHS OC pupils representing BSOA at the World Schools Championships. Fundraising has been ongoing.

Following the 2019 WSOC, the International School Sports Federation, changed the format of the championships and BSOA decided to no longer send any teams. At the same time numbers orienteering at UVHS declined, so the trustees expanded the remit of the fund to cover juniors in the South Lakes region and renamed the fund as South Lakeland Junior Orienteering Foundation
