

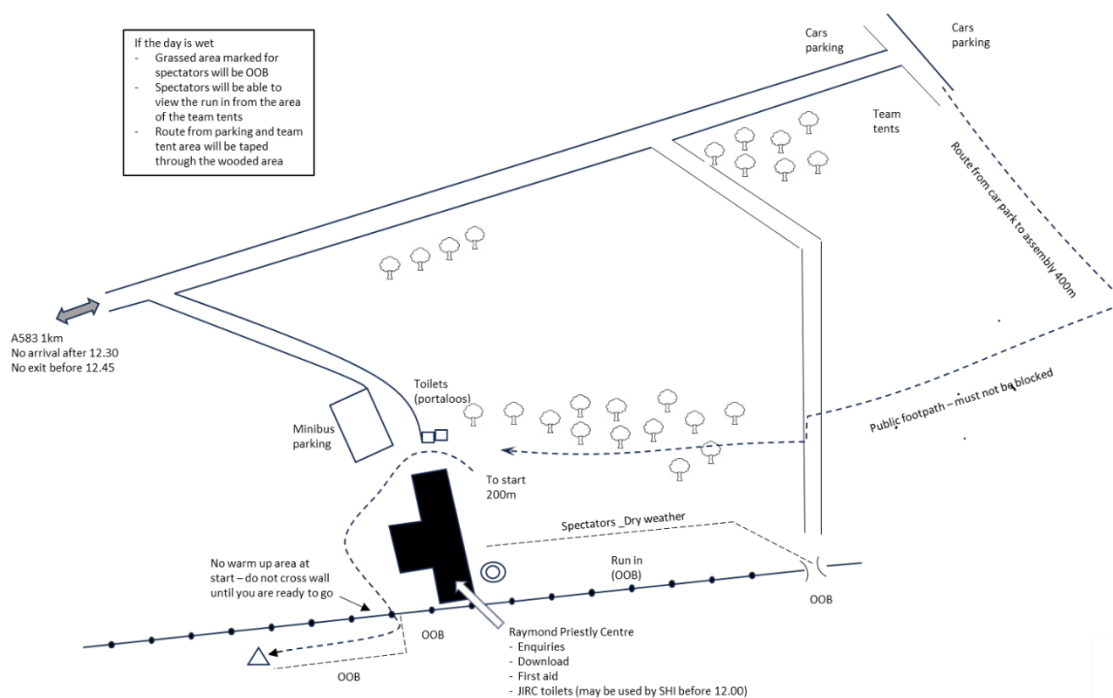
SHI 27 & 28 September 2025

Bulletin 3

This Bulletin only contains changes / additions to Bulletin 2. For other details please refer to Bulletin 2.

Saturday – Individual

Parking will now be 300m – 400m (not 200m as previously advised) from Assembly.



Due to the recent wet weather any team tents will have to be erected by the parking, and for the same reason spectator access by the run-in is likely to be reduced.

Following further testing, the maximum time-out in each direction will be 5 minutes (not 4 as previously advised), to give adequate time to properly open and close the 3 gates in the timeout section. Will all runners please ensure you close these gates behind you.

Sunday – Relay

Please note the following non-IOF standard mapping details :

White - rough open grass (predominantly marram grass)

Pale Orange - open sand

X - man-made features - these may be disused / ruined farm equipment or similar

Bibs for the relay will be red (Leg 1), white (Leg 2) and blue (Leg 3).

Map issue will be in a tent. Enter and have your bibs visible for a number check. There will be clear and check stations at the tent. Competitors will then proceed into the start/changeover pen. Maps will be folded and sealed. Any attempt to see the map before the start will render the competitor's team liable to disqualification.

As on Day 1, both contactless (SIAC) and physical (SI) punching will work. There will also be manual pin punches at each control and a clear punch mark on the map will be accepted in case of electronic equipment failure.

After punching their finish control, Leg 1 and 2 runners should touch the hand of their next runner and then continue to download at the signed trailer unit. Leg 3 runners will be directed to a right-hand channel on their run-in and dib their finish control, then continue to download.

Leg 1 and Leg 2 runners' maps must be handed in at download and may be collected once all Leg 3 runners have started.
